LOCAL RULES

14th May 2023



In addition to the Austrian Golf Association Hard Card, the following local rules are applicable:

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- Clubhouse and car park as defined by white stakes and adjoining white line. This boundary is located to the right of hole 1, to the right of hole 10 until parking area and the whole greenkeeping area between holes 3 & 5.
- To the left and rear of hole 8 as defined by white stakes and adjoining white line.
- To the left of hole 9 as defined by white stakes and adjoining white line. Where this white line joins the tarmac road, this becomes the boundary of the course for rest of holes 9 and 10.

2. Markings

- Penalty Area (Rule 17.1) – defined by red stakes or adjoining red lines
- blue – 50 m / red – 100 m / yellow – 150 m / white – 200 m - Distance to the green

3. Ground under repair – GUR (Rule 16.1)

- Open drainage (gravel) and areas marked with white broken line or white dots
- Flower fields with daffodils marked with white broken lines

4. Abnormal Course Conditions (inc. Immovable Obstructions) (Rule 16)

- All artificially surfaced roads and paths.
- The tennis court and surrounding fence to the right of holes 1 and 18.
- The halfway house between greens 9 and 18 is linked to the cart path with a white line so it is part of the same condition.
- Flag Poles on 18th.

5. Abnormal Course Conditions – Animal Hole (MPR F-6)

- Relief is not allowed if animal hole only interferes with the player's stance

6. Integral objects:

- Tree basins – individual wooden chips are loose impediments.

7. Power Lines (MLR E-11):

- If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line [or tower or a wire or pole supporting a power line] during the play of holes 8, 14 & 17 the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6 for what to do).

8. The use of electronic distance measuring devices is permitted (Rule 4.3)

- Only for distance-measuring without any additional function

9. Caddies are allowed

10. RECORDING AREA

- Please return your scorecard immediately after play to the secretary located in proshop
- Livescoring after hole 9 at the halfway

11. Suspension of Play (Rule 5.7) COURSE EVACUATION PROCEDURE

- If Play is **SUSPENDED** for a **dangerous Situation**, (by **ONE LONG BLAST** to the Klaxon), Play shall **STOP IMMEDIATELY**. **Players must return to the Course Evacuation Places**
- If Play is suspended for a **Non-Dangerous Situation** (by **3 short Blast** to the Klaxon), the Player may complete a Hole already started.

in this case Players shall remain on the Course and wait for advice from a Referee

- **2 short BLAST** to the Klaxon: Resuming Play
- Lightning Protection Huts are behind Greens 10 & 14, behind Tee 8 and Halfway Station
